The Company operates its Timber Centre and Pallets and Boxes Manufacturing Plant in the most environmentally sound way possible. All timber received for pallet and case production is all derived from indigenous, sustainable forests, managed under the United Kingdom’s stringent forestry standards administered by the Forestry Authority

Our policy is to comply fully with all current legislation and regulations and to seek to exceed the requirements wherever possible.

The Company is committed to the responsible purchasing of forest products. The long-term aim is to source all forest products purchased or specified from well-managed forests that have been certified to credible certification standards.

The Company does its utmost to minimise the impact of the production process on the surrounding environment.

We seek to ensure the use of energy is minimized and maximum advantage is made of opportunities to recycle and reuse materials, thereby minimising waste.

Employees are provided with ongoing training to ensure environmental responsibilities are recognised and there is an open door policy in relation to suggestions for improvement.

Our processes and procedures are continually reviewed with a view to improving our environmental performance.
